Subject: - Clarification regarding registration of death in case of decomposed body.

Sir,

Please refer to your office letter No. HIVS/D-83/deceased in case of PM Report/3880-81/2019 dated 06/03/2019 vide which you have forwarded a query raised by Chief Officer, Ratnagiri Municipal Council regarding determination of date of death in case of decomposed body whose Post Mortem report does not specify the exact date of death.

In this connection, it is to inform that in such cases where exact date of death has not been mentioned in post mortem report, the date on which the police found the dead body may be treated as the date of death of deceased. Further it is also suggested to specifically mention in remarks column of death register that "the exact date of death could not be ascertained in the post mortem report".
