Sub: Guidance regarding registration of adopted child in Muslim religion-regarding.

Sir,

This is in reference to your letter dated 06.12.2018 in respect of subject cited above vide which this office circular dated 15.05.2015 was referred and guidance has been sought on whether the circular dated 15.05.2015 applicable in respect of referred case or whether there is another circular for non-institution adoption in Muslim religion.

2. In this connection, it is to clarified that this office circular dated 15.05.2015 was issued in respect of making / change entries in the birth record of the children taken through non-institutional adoption which covered under 'Hindu Adoption and Maintenance (HAMA) Act, 1956', hence the said circular is applicable only to Hindus, Buddhist, Jains & Sikhs. Also, no specific circular on making /changing entries in the birth records for children taken on adoption through non-institution in Muslim religion has been issued by this office till now. Therefore, the matter under consideration was referred to Central Adoption Resource Authority (CARA) for guidance vide this office letter of even no. dated 19.02.2019. In response to this office said letter, the clarification from CARA vide their letter dated 26.03.2019 has been received.

3. In view of the above, it is to clarify that any non-institutional adoption in Muslims, Christians, Parsis and Jews should be carried under the provisions of Juvenile Justice (JJ) Act, 2015 & Adoption Regulations 2017 are concluded through a court order under section 61 of the JJ Act, 2015.
